Hi Nobles - a word on the Al Malaikah Ambassador Corp and its role in membership.





Dear Nobles & Friends,

It is my pleasure to invite you to join us for what will be Al Malaikah's 37th consecutive trip to the largest single sporting event in the world; The Indianapolis 500 Race.

This year will be the 102nd year for the race and promises to be an outstanding event. We will leave on an early flight, Wednesday May 23rd and return on Monday May 28th. The trip package as planned includes the following:

- Round trip airfare from LAX.
- All ground transportation in Indianapolis.
- Five (5) nights housing at the newly upgraded Holiday Inn Indianapolis-Carmel including a Full Hot Breakfast Buffet daily.
- Gasoline Alley tours and Race Day tickets, (great seats on the outside of the first turn).
- Factory tour of the Dallara Indy Car Co plus we are working on additional activities & Tours.
- All dinners.
- A barbeque dinner with Murat Temple's Potentate, Divan, Past Potentates and the Imperial Potentate.
- Parade seats and continental breakfast on Saturday.
- Race day breakfast, box lunch, and police escorted bus transportation to the track.
- All refreshments in the Hospitality Room.

At this time, it is too early to finalize the exact costs, however we estimate the cost to come in at about \$2000.00, or hopefully less depending on the airfare.

As in previous years, this is a revenue neutral activity. Any funds left over after expenses will be refunded to the participants. Or if there is a shortage all participants will be billed the difference.

In order to get our race tickets, we had to purchase them last June. We will have to pay the hotel and airlines the deposits in the near future. Your quick response would be appreciated. If we do not hear from you by February 28, 2018, we will assume you are not interested in going.

We will also be obtaining the passes for Gasoline Alley soon, so we will have entrance to it as we have in the past years.


