

# **Old Spanish Day Parade**

he 95th version of The Old Spanish Days parade, always held on the First Friday in August, in Santa Barbara, CA, is a traditional visit by the Al Malaikah Potentate to ride in a Santa Barbara Shrine Club sponsored carriage. This parade is the largest equestrian parade in the nation with no motorized units.

Although the Club was chartered in 1920, this Club tradition began in 1984 and has been supported every year since by the Al Malaikah Potentate, who comes to Santa Barbara for a leisurely ride on the parade route where over 25,000 people can see the Fez and hear the announcers talk about Shriners Hospitals for Children.

This 35th time was as special as ever with Potentate Bruce Ponoroff bringing his wife Andi and Chief Rabban Seb Badoyan with wife Judy. It is also part of the Club tradition to invite the Chief Rabban for this colorful and historic event to show the Fez. With Club Host Noble Bruce Rick and wife Evelyn, this Shrine-family mix made

for a great day of sharing and celebrating.

The Shriners sometimes ride in a wagon, sometimes a surrey, one time a stagecoach. All are restored and maintained by the Santa Barbara Carriage Museum. No signs or banners are allowed, but the Fez needs no introduction. This year's parade featured more than 680 participants, including horses and riders, floats, marching bands and mariachi groups, walking groups, dancers, antique carriages, coaches and wagons. About 80 different units participated in the Fiesta Historical Parade.

"When you are riding along, there are so many peo-

ple that recognize the Fez and say 'Thank you for what you do for kids' or 'my dad or granddad or uncle was a Shriner', that makes it special for me," said Potentate Ponoroff. Said Chief Rabban Badoyan, "We saw families set up with food, sitting on lawn chairs or on the curb, and you know this is a big deal in Santa Barbara. This is the biggest parade I've ever been in!"

As the huge crowd of spectators watched along the nearly two-mile parade route.

Noble Maurice Sourmany, a parade watcher, native of Santa Barbara, and Shrine Club member said, "The parade is a beautiful event and no matter how many times I see it, there are highlights to make it different and special. And, we always look for the Fez and the Potentate so we can say thanks for coming!"

All along the main parade route State Street, where the carriages, walkers and riders are very close to the spectators, jovial words are often exchanged between those in the parade and those on the sidelines. Much of it starts with the famous vocal cry "Viva la Fiesta!", and many yell "Hey, Shriners, Shriners!"


