

FIRST LADY'S PROJECT 2019

SHRINER'S FOR CHILDREN MEDICAL CENTER PASADENA

My project this year has been to purchase virtual reality headsets for use in the many treatments our patients require. These treatments range from cast removal to four-hour long transfusions. Due to discomfort, apprehension and fear, many of our patients require the use of opioids to relax and sedate them so their treatments can be performed. Unfortunately, the use of such drugs can lead to drug abuse and teenage males in particular are more likely to suffer from addiction to these drugs down the road.

The use of virtual reality technology allows the patient to visit a far-away land, play games or embark on adventure of their choosing. How, you ask? The headsets are powered by an iphone type of device placed into a headset. The patient uses their eyes to select what they would like to do or play. The patient is focused on what they want to be doing and are distracted from the procedure being performed on them. This process eliminates the use of drugs, in most cases, allowing the patient to relax and be still during the process.

With the use of these devices, our medical center is now 92% opioid free. Each of these units have a purchase price of \$2,500.00. My goal was to purchase a total of 5 devices. Through many generous donations, we have been able to purchase 4 for the medical center and look to finish our commitment for the year with the final purchase of 1 more for a total of 5 units. We are short of our goal by \$500 and we need your help.
