



Next year will be the 104th year for the race, and it promises to be an outstanding event. We will leave on an early flight Wednesday, May 20th, and return on Monday, May 25th.

The trip package as planned includes the following:

- · Round trip airfare from LAX
- · All ground transportation in Indianapolis
- Five (5) nights housing at the newly upgraded Crowne Plaza Hotel—Indianapolis/Airport
- Gasoline Alley Tours, and Race Day tickets (great seats on the outside of the first turn)
- Factory tour of the Dallara Indy Car Co. (if available); plus, we are working on additional activities
- All dinners
- Barbeque dinner with Murat Temple's Potentate, Divan, Past Potentates, and the Imperial Potentate
- · Parade seats and continental breakfast on Saturday
- Race day breakfast, box lunch, and police escorted bus transportation to the track on Sunday
