"Which way is the water?"

That's the familiar chant that the members of Beach Cities Shrine Club use when engaging the crowds while riding aboard our float in parades around the Southland. "Which way is the water?" We get six different answers to that question with parade-goers pointing in different directions. Why? Because we cruise through a parade in a WWII lifeboat that was used in the 1944 Normandy invasion. The hole in the bow has long been patched, but you certainly can't miss us! We're the ones laughing in a boat, sailing down the street, under the colorful Viking sail emblazoned with our name and our logo.





With oars protruding from the sides, and our president sitting at the tiller, we're steering for fun and looking for water! And the crowds earnestly try to get us to "row, row, row your boat..."

And if all of that isn't enough fun, we've got motorized camels and a pooper-scooper running around the boat to further engage the audience. Children really love our camel entertainment! Our camels "spit" and "poop" for the audience while the camel wrangler (aka the pooper-scooper) chases them through the streets with a broom, screaming "bad camel" as they flaunt their ability to outrun him.



We obtained our boat many years ago when we were the Los Angeles Harbor Shrine Club. The boat theme and decorations changed every year and has appeared in parades as a steamboat, a pirate ship, and a Viking ship, among others. Then, we added to the fun when the El Toga Shrine Club merged with

us to become the Beach Cities Shrine Club.

That's when we inherited our

now-familiar camels. Long ago, the camels used to be worn over the shoulders with suspenders and were walked through the parades, but then at some point they became motorized and were actually ridden in

parades. The familiar costume for the camel riders were homemade Arabic robes, but those were sadly discontinued after September 11, 2001.

We regularly spend Presidents Weekend riding in the parade for Whiskey Flats Days in Kernville. It's an entire weekend of eating and socializing...surrounded by a parade. The ladies (and some of the guys) love playing Left-Right-Center, attempting to steal pennies from each other. MEET YOUR KOPPERS

THE FUN ENFORCEMENT UNIT

The Al Malakiah Koppers are considered the "fun enforcement" unit of the Al Malakiah Shrine Temple. They were formed in the early 1960s after the Golden Boot Patrol was disbanded. Initially it was not a recognized unit, it was several graduate patrolmen (active in law enforcement) who were interested having fun and playing pranks on the Potentate. After Roger Murdock (a Deputy Chief of LAPD) was installed as potentate in 1963, his first formal function was a breakfast with the Westwood Shrine Club. This function was generally very well attended by perhaps 700-800 Shriners in the audience, who were shocked when a squad





of Keystone Kops in full long coat uniform wearing Bobbie helmets, police badges, swinging night sticks and blowing police whistles. They mounted the podium and took the microphone from the MC. Whereupon they announced to the gathering they were "arresting the new Potentate for unspecified crimes". As they took him off the stage a 3'x4' metal jail, fully equipped with bars and mounted on wheels, appeared at the back of the Resturant. The Koppers locked the new Potentate up the announced they would release him once the audience posted "bail". The Koppers collected a substantial sum from the audience, which was donated to the Shriners Hospital.

The next day the new Potentate made the Koppers an official unit of Al Malakiah Temple with the duty of arresting him at every POV, that year.

The Koppers continue their fun loving irreverent outlook not to honor each newly minted Potentate just after his election in January, but to host his "Last Supper" between Christmas and New Years, for a great beef steak dinner in recognition of his upcoming year of "Chicken Dinners".

Recently our unit has been honored by having the following Potentates selected from our ranks Illustrious all Glen Christensen 2006, Hal Justice 2008, David Wehmeyer 2012, Mike Wolfe 2016, Guy Richmond 2018, Bruce Ponoroff 2019.

Much has happened with the Unit since 1962, we have acquired a 1923 Ford Model T squad car and a 1926 Paddy wagon. We now parade for fun and hi-jinks to entertain the crowds, for many years we performed in the Hollywood Christmas Parade. We now have a Squad room on Royal St, above the Shrine ticket office and our roll call is at 1730 on the third Wednesday on every month (except August) followed by a fun filled meeting and dinner. 2020 finds our Captain "Mighty" David Leija directing his Officers in proper tactics and methods of "Fun Enforcement". After the pandemic is over you might want to contact the Captain about exploring a career in "Fun Enforcement", his number is 423-791-0811. Maybe he might invite you to dinner and appoint you a probationer complete with a brand-new set of stripes, horizontal black and white prisoners' stripes on your new jail uniform.

"A new era of human spaceflight is set to begin as American astronauts once again launch on an American rocket from American soil to the International Space Station as part of NASA's Commercial Crew Program. NASA astronauts Robert Behnken and Douglas Hurley will fly on SpaceX's Crew Dragon spacecraft, lifting off on a Falcon 9 rocket at 3:22 p.m. EDT May 30, from Launch Complex 39A in Florida, for an extended stay at the space station for the Demo-2 mission. The specific duration of the mission is to be determined.

As the final flight test for SpaceX, this mission will validate the company's crew transportation system, including the launch pad, rocket, spacecraft, and operational capabilities. This also will be the first time NASA astronauts will test the spacecraft systems in orbit".

Like this history making event in space, so is the time for Al Malaikah to make history.



As a result, many states' regulatory bodies will no longer allow us to use our corporate name, Shriners Hospitals for Children, to describe the care we provide in an outpatient setting.

Shriners Hospitals for Children has traditionally had a very strong "master brand" strategy with all of our facilities holding the same name. Recent evolutions in health care have changed that. Our five outpatient facilities each have different names such as Shriners for Children Medical Center™ — Pasadena, or The Erie Shriners Medical Center. The goal of any brand is to create consistency to increase brand equity. The recent announcement of our new brand, Shriners Children's™, is a step toward unifying all of our locations, regardless of the means of providing care, under one brand. This is not a name change, but a change in our brand strategy to meet the constantly evolving world of health care.

From a fraternal perspective, the branding is going from four words to two words, and the branding simply focuses on who is providing care and who is being served. For nearly 100 years, our mission has been to work consistently to build a health care brand synonymous with outstanding medial expertise and the most amazing care anywhere. Due to this reputation, we are able to shorten our brand, something consumers prefer in today's digital age.

There has also been some concern raised over how the name will function with its possessive ending. The brand will be used as a master brand with a more specific label following. For example one of our research initiatives in Genomics, could become Shriners Children's Genomic Institute. This branding convention is heavily utilized within pediatric healthcare, and well known to consumers as it is currently used by the majority of top pediatric brands.

We all take a great deal of pride in the world's greatest philanthropy that bears our name, and that, will never change. Shriners have helped provide life changing medical treatment to more than 1.4 million children, regardless of the family's ability to pay. We all want to see even more children served than ever before. We believe this new brand will help guide us into a future that promises more opportunities to change even more lives. 





In 1996 the Grand Lodge Committee on MSBs published an updated Operational Guideline with Rules and Regulations that included a requirement that all Lodges join a MSB nearest its meeting place. In 2002 the Grand Lodge Committee on MSBs was eliminated and its duties assigned to the Grand Secretary. By that time, lodge membership in such MSBs was optional.

Between 2002 and 2019, the number of MSBs dwindled to only two: The Greater Sacramento Area MSB and the Los Angeles MSB and had become another of our Fraternity's best kept secrets. The need for the kinds of investigations, and the other services which were seen as needed in the 1970's, were not as important today as it once was with the advent of contemporary means of communication and may have contributed to the current reduction in the number of MSBs.

Advance communication technology has not deterred the members of the Los Angeles Masonic Service Bureau. Our officers and members continue to follow through with providing the following services as "Your Partner in Service" to our beloved Craft:






Glenn currently hand- crafts beautiful pieces of jewelry that many of his brothers and their ladies are lucky enough to wear.
