There were well over 100 youth, 100 adult advisors and dozens of guests and families participating in the convention all weekend long. It was a wonderful gathering of old friends, new brothers and a huge supporting cast welcoming DeMolay back to the in person gathering we all have loved and cherished for several generations of DeMolay. From Friday night with the In N Out Burger Truck and opening ceremonies, Saturday's degree classes and Squire investiture to the tearful goodbyes on Sunday night of our 2020-2021 youth leaders, the weekend was full of incredible moments and splendor.

The 20/21 team of Jurisdiction Officers included: Andrew Caster – Jurisdiction Master Councilor, Carmichael Viola – Deputy Master Councilor, Aaron Philips – Congress Secretary and Miss MacKenzie Keister – Jurisdiction Sweetheart. These officers inherited a new term still faced with Covid-19 and a world of Zoom meetings, but they did a wonderful job of guiding the youth to the other side of things and back to in person meetings, events and of course, Conclave! The big installations take place on Sunday morning and evening for the youth with all of the League Officers being installed during brunch on Sunday morning. The Jurisdiction Officers are installed Sunday evening during the Grand Banquet – thus the Changing of the Guard. With the final rap of the Jurisdiction Gavel, the 2021-2022 officers are now fully vested with the responsibilities to lead the chapters and members of the jurisdiction. The new team of officers – led by Connell Hickey – Jurisdiction Master Councilor, Christopher Kruse – Deputy Master Councilor, Jody Williams – Congress Secretary, Miss Sarah Garrett – Jurisdiction Sweetheart and Miss Victorya Keister – Jurisdiction Princess, have an ambitious schedule of activities planned for the next year to help kick start membership again growing our chapters, leagues and jurisdiction.

What is DeMolay you ask...Let me tell you:

DeMolay is the largest youth fraternity in the world. The Order of DeMolay was started over 102 years ago (1919) in Kansas City, Missouri by a Shriner/Scottish Rite Mason, "Dad" Frank S. Land. DeMolay is a character-building organization for young men who are 12 to 21 years of age. In over 700 chapters throughout the United States, these young men have the opportunity to develop management, leadership and social skills as they participate in community projects, sports, and educational programs. DeMolay also has chapters in Canada, Brazil, Australia, Germany, Panama, Japan, Italy, and the Republic of the Philippines.

More than two million young men have been members of DeMolay. The organization helps members to develop civic awareness and responsibility. DeMolay provides young men the opportunity to practice leadership techniques and the real-world application of the same through its chapter activities. The organization assists young men in growing into responsible adults with good moral character while providing them a place to go, have fun, enjoy companionship, be accepted by peers and develop solid values. DeMolay is not only teaching young people about the working tools of life, it is serving as the cornerstone of our next generation.

DeMolay has a "Pledge Program" called the Order of the Squires for young boys 9-12 years old which provides them a fun group to be apart of that is run by our Squire "Moms" and the guidance of a "Sir Knight" an experienced DeMolay to be the Big Brother to the younger Squires. When these young men have completed their time in our Squire Manors, we see a large percentage of them join their local DeMolay Chapters, of which there are roughly 35 chapters in Southern California for a young man to join from San Diego to San Luis Obispo. These young men are the future of Masonry, Al Malaikah Shrine, the Scottish Rite and York Rite bodies and the relationships they forge with their advisors is key to them moving into Masonry.

DeMolay needs your help to continue our great work and there are several ways you can participate with the program:

- 1.If your lodge currently doesn't have or support a DeMolay chapter, check into getting one started and make that commitment to building a chapter for the young men of your local communities.
- 2.Become an Advisor of your local chapter and give your time/unique talents to the young men of DeMolay as a adult leader in SCJ DeMolay
- 3.Share DeMolay with the young men you come into contact with through your families, religious institutions or other social groups you know. We need new members for all our chapters – send us your young men!

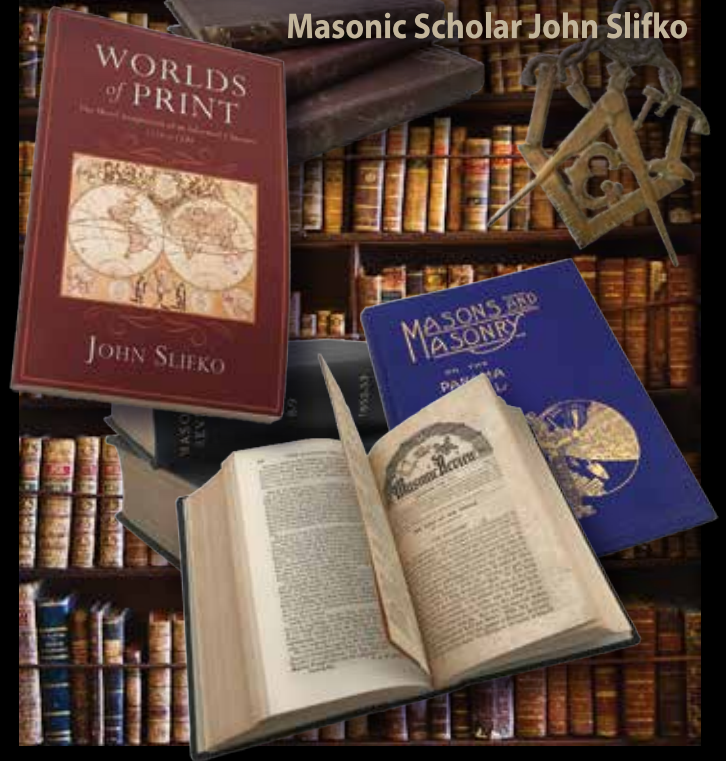

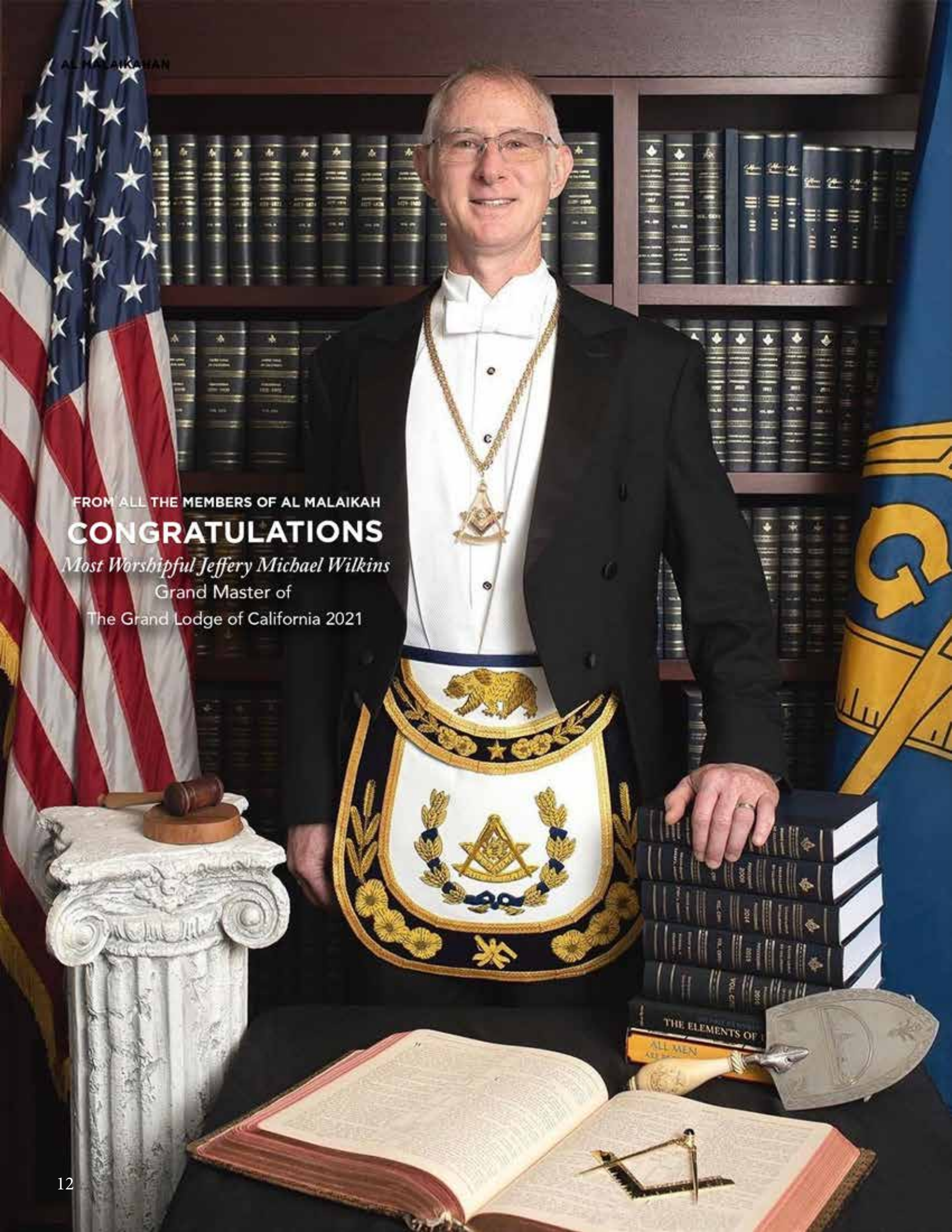
I hope that as you all have played a role in my life, I was and also be able to play a positive role in yours.

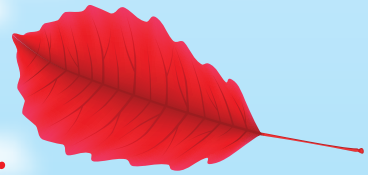
