Mary Shaw FirstLady Al Malaikah Shrine

My career has been 30+ years in the fashion industry. Either as a textile designer or colorist and later years in higher education for the industry. I love color and I love putting clothes together. Many in the fashion industry would say that "Clothes make the Person" and that it defines who you are. I would agree that it can possibly define you... it can be your 'uniform'.

During the last month, I have had the opportunity to experience and learn more about the importance of the 'uniforms' of the Cleft Lip & Palate medical team at Shriners Children's Southern California Medical Center. As a reminder, my First Lady's Project this year is "Creating Brighter Smiles, Changing Lives and More..." by supporting the Cleft Lip & Palate department. I had the opportunity to shadow the doctors of the Cleft Lip & Palate and Plastic Surgery department on a Friday at the center. Friday is their clinic day, and it is very busy with patients. I was made to feel like one of the team. I shadowed Dr. Bill McGee, who is the head of Oral Surgery/ Cleft Palate & Lip for the Pasadena Center. He is a trailblazer in the medical field of

Cleft Palate & Lip. Cassie Rodriguez-Feo, physician assistant was my main contact and so incredibly kind. The medical teams wear scrubs and the doctors wear either scrubs or business casual with their white coats. Again, the uniforms of the angels at the clinic. Easy to identify those who are on the front line daily for our patients and are providing hope and cures for a better life. An unexpected group of angels were the interpreters at the medical center and on the telehealth zoom calls. Their uniforms were scrubs or street clothes. However, do not be fooled, they were an important part of making the families and patients for whom English is not their first language, feel comfortable and that someone is there to help. In the clinic, we met with patients and their parents or guardians to discuss ongoing care or upcoming surgeries. I was introduced to the patients, and I got to tell a little bit about being the wife of a Shriner and the Potentate, and my project. I explained that all monies from the project stay in Pasadena to support the Cleft Lip & Palate patients. The families and patients were lovely and so gracious and thankful for what we do. We also spent time in Telehealth zoom meetings with patients who are at a Shrine clinic in Mexico. The following Monday, I was allowed with the permission of the patient's families and Dr. McGee to scrub in for two surgeries. They were the most AMAZING EXPERIENCES! They told me that I was the first First Lady to scrub in for surgery at the Pasadena Center. Before you can enter the surgical wing, you must put on the 'uniform'. I changed out of my street clothes into the medical bunny suit of scrubs including a hat and booties. Dr. McGee and Dr. Rick Bushnell, Chief of Anesthesia, a Shriner with Al Malaikah, were both amazing at allowing me to get very close to see and to ask many questions. The first surgery was for a two-year-old girl who was having her lip cleft corrected. It was a very straightforward surgery. However, none of these surgeries are easy. The second surgery was for a 16-year-old girl who had had her lip & palate surgically corrected at another medical facility previously. The expander in her mouth to help with orthodontics had opened the palate. This was causing her issues with eating, possible infection, and any fluids she drank would come out her nose. Her's was a two-step surgery. First, they would correct the palate. Secondly, they were going to make some corrections on her nose. Cleft lip patients can have one side of their nose be flatter, because of the weight of the cleft lip and pulling of the area below the nose. Dr. McGee first fixed and corrected a deviated septum, then corrected the flatter side of her nose with cartilage that was removed from the deviated septum. While this patient was perfect before the surgery, she would be so happy with the perfectly shaped nose they created for her. I had only positive takeaways after my two days of shadowing in the Cleft Lip & Palate department. One is that possibly every staff member I met, wanted to share with me that they thought the Shriners Childrens Southern

California Medical Center was the BEST place they had ever worked. Hands Down. Two, the staff are caring and dedicated to the cause of good health and well-being for our patients and their families. I'd like to think after my days in clinic and surgery, that scrubs are the uniforms of angels. The individuals who grace those rooms are angels on earth for our patients. They are making the lives of so many children better with each medical exam and surgery. We do the charity work we do because we all have a kind heart and care, but it is a totally different perspective experiencing it first-hand. 
## Hello Nobles, Ladies, Widows, and Families,

As you know, we are an outpatient facility, but the extended stay allows us to cover one overnight stay of care. Most of our families that come to us for Cleft Palate will be financially incapable to cover many of the costs. Cleft & Lip Palate are complex conditions, which not only affect the child's appearance and self-esteem, but also a child's ability to breathe, speak, hear, and eat properly.

### A Few Facts about Cleft & Lip Palate

- What is Cleft Palate? It is a condition that occurs when there is a gap in the roof of the mouth. The tissues that form the roof of the mouth do not join.
- What is Cleft Lip? When the child is born with a gap in the upper lip. The skin, muscle and inner lining of the lip may be missing in the lip. It can extend all the way to the nose.
- Facial Clefts occur in nearly one in 600 births in the United States.
- Why do children get cleft lip & palate? Doctors & Researchers do not have complete answers to this question. It can be caused by environmental factors and/or genetics, however, many times a direct cause is never found.
- Correcting Cleft & Lip Palate is **NEVER** done in one surgery. Generally, most patients will have 8-9 surgeries through the age of 20 to correct all factors of their condition. Our patients will need unique dental and orthodontic care during different stages of the child's growth. In addition to possibly working with audiologist and ear, nose and throat surgeons in regard to hearing issues. Additionally, Speech Therapists and Psychologists are involved in the patient's total care.




