#### URGENT NOTICE REGARDING SHRINE PARKING

#### Fellow Al Malaikah Nobles:

ome exciting news about parking at the Al Malaikah Temple. Beginning July 1st, parking at the Shrine will finally be entering the 21st Century.

We are installing an automated system for parking

at the garage entrance, eventually expanding to the Jefferson West Lot gate as well.

For now the West lot will still be accessed on a regular day by driving into the garage and crossing Royal into the West Lot. Other times we may have the West Lot gates opened for different reasons but for now use the 32nd St entrance of the garage.



The new system will require you to download to your smartphone an app called ZipBy. Instructions are in the attachment to this email. All you need to do is scan the QR code to find the app in the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.

It will ask you for payment info but do not worry. As a Shriner you continue to park for free when you visit the Shrine on Temple, Unit or personal visit. Nobles will still, as always, pay for parking if they are attending a show that is not a Shriner show, etc...

This system works via Bluetooth on your smartphone and senses you approaching and the gate will open before you are even able to come to a full and complete stop at the booth!

If you do not have a smartphone, don't worry, you can still identify yourself at the booth and the attendant will open the gate.

Over time though, the hours of the attendant will be minimized as we develop a timing/use database.

I intend this to be as seamless as possible. But, as we all know, with technology comes challenges. I hope for these to be few and far between.

Fun & Fellowship...has been the focus of our theme for the year, while supporting our patients and medical centers. The Nobles & Ladies of Al Malaikah have not disappointed.

I'd like to again Thank Everyone who has supported and contributed to my First Lady's Project, Creating Brighter Smiles, Changing Lives and More...the Cleft Lip & Palette department at Shriners Childrens Southern California Medical Center. If you would still like to contribute to my project, it is not too late. You can mail donations to First Lady's Project 2023, c/o Mary Shaw, 3750 Pacific Ave, Long Beach, CA 90807. Make checks payable to: Shriners Childrens Southern California Medical Center. Please remember that on the subject line, you MUST write Mary Shaw, 1st Lady Project, Al Malaikah Shrine. This will ensure that the monies donated will go directly to my project.

The monies that are raised will help fund our new Cleft Palate Extended Stay Program. As an outpatient facility, the extended stay allows us to cover one overnight stay of care. Another option with our funds is providing Welcome Bags to new patients. Depending on the age of the patient, the bag could include Cleft Lip bottles and nipples, bibs, toys, blankets, etc.

### What is Cleft Palate?

It is a condition that occurs when there is a gap in the roof of the mouth of the child. The tissues that form the roof of the mouth do not join together during the development of the child in utero.

What is Cleft Lip? When the child is born with a gap in the upper lip. The skin, muscle, and inner lining of the lip may be missing in the lip area.

Correcting Cleft & Lip Palate is NEVER done in just one surgery. Generally, most patients will have 8-9 surgeries through the age of 20 to correct all factors of their condition.

Facial Clefts occur in nearly one in 600 births in the United States.



#### SHRINERS CHILDREN PASADENA

our Medical Center in Pasadena has new people, new locations, and facilities, but still the best care anywhere.

First, we have a new head of Donor Development. Alexa Barajas joins us as the director of Donor Development. She comes to us from UCLA fund raising, and actually started her career with us at Shriners Hospital Los Angeles about ten years ago. She is excited to be working with us again and has jumped right into this new position, picking up where Aaron left off. She is already hard at work developing contacts and potential

sources for donations and support. Remember that a major portion of our budget is made up of donations and your support is always welcomed.

One more thing, speaking of Donor Development. Along with our new director came a change to the name of the department. This is now the Office of Philanthropy. New name, same mission, to help support Shriners Children's, Southern California

Next, we are finally very close to signing up with Harbor UCLA. We will be able to extend our care to the south bay. Opening a clinic here will enable us to do more surgeries closer to where the children are. It allows more operating room time for our doctors at a facility with a PICU available. It is hoped that soon we will have similar "clinics" in other Southern California locations, such as Riverside.

We are also working with the Los Angeles County burn center. This will bring some of their burn and reconstruction patients to our facility. We have added a plastic surgeon to our staff to assist with this added care.

Meanwhile, we continue to increase the traffic at our Medical Center. Our intakes have steadily increased over last year, and we are still on track to exceed the number of surgeries from last year. At our current rate we will exceed our target of 705 surgeries this year. A huge



increase from the 634 surgeries performed by our doctors last year. And still there is plenty of room for growth. There was even talk about activating the unbuilt third Operating Room at the Medical Center, but we aren't there yet.

Our Tijuana clinic continues to grow. Exceeding targets and continuing to care for children closer to their homes. Not only with this facility in Tijuana, but also with tele-health facilities in Hermosillo. This clinic will soon be joined by new clinics in Guadalajara, and Chihuahua in Mexico. So, as you can see, your Shriners Children's Medical system is growing. Not only our facility here in Pasadena, but all across North America



## In Memoriam

## **Dennis C. Shaffer**

September 1, 1942 – March 13, 2023 99th Illustrious Potentate (1997) Al Malaikah Temple, Shriners International

llustrious Sir Dennis Shaffer was born in Glendale, California. He served as an ex-officio member of the Board of Governors of the Shriners Hospital for Children, Los Angeles, and of the Al Malaikah Temple's Board of Trustees. He was also one of the Directors of the Al Malaikah Auditorium Company. His Imperial appointments included that of Imperial Aide and member of the Imperial Shrine Insurance Committee.

His service to Al Malaikah continued to the very end. He was an insurance advisor to the Auditorium Company until his passing. He enjoyed travel. Most recently, he and Lady Linda made an adventurous cross-county RV trek with Ill. Sir Ken Judd and Lady Margie. He was an avid sportsman and a terrific golfer. Golf was his passion throughout his life. He loved the thrill of competing in golf tournaments. Dennis always felt that a man's integrity is measured on the golf course. If he cheats on the course, he'll cheat you in business.

Illustrious Sir Dennis left behind his wife Linda of 40 years, his sons Robert, Blake (Elaine) and daughter Lynda Larkin (Jack); eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Also left behind is his sister Verda Ann Olson (Curtis) and four nieces.

His dedication to the Fraternity of Masonry, as well as the Shrine was well known and recognized by all who knew him.

He is missed.
