

Black Camel ILLUSTRIOUS SIR MONTE STARR


ILLUSTRIOUS SIR MONTE STARR passed away after a long illness. He was 74 years old. Ill. Monte died on the morning of September 11, 2023 in New Bern, North Carolina from complications related to Agent Orange exposure during his service in Viet Nam. He was born in Riverside California on Mother's Day 1949. He went to school through the first year of college in San Bernardino. In 1969 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and spent time in Alaska and Viet Nam. After his military service he spent 29 years in the Federal Aviation Administration. He retired in January 2002. Monte was raised in Glacier Lodge #303, Anchorage, Alaska and later affiliated with Bakersfield Lodge #224 where he served as Master in 1999. He was a member of several appendant Masonic bodies. He joined Al Malaikah Shrine in 1978 and served as Temple Membership Chairman and Flying Eagles Commander as well as on numerous Temple Committees. He was appointed to the progressive Divan in 1999 by Illustrious Sir Gene Moore. He served as Potentate of Al Malaikah Shrine in 2005. During his year he dedicated the "Editorial Without Words" statue and started Cigars Under the Stars. Monte and Lady Lora relocated to New Bern, NC where he affiliated with Sudan Shriners and started the Cooligans, who rode motorized ice chests in parades. Funeral services will be Saturday, September 16 in North Carolina.

THE SHRINER'S FEZ: A SYMBOL OF UNITY AND BROTHERHOOD

In the heart of the Al Malaikah Shrine, one Shriner's journey unveils the deeper meaning of their fraternity, highlighting the significance of unity and brotherhood that transcends charity work. 
The Shriner, our central character, was initially drawn to the Al Malaikah Shrine by the grand ceremonies and benevolent events that unfolded within its hallowed walls. The camaraderie he experienced and the shared sense of purpose were unlike anything he had ever encountered before. For several months, he threw himself headlong into the activities, attending every gathering, and passionately participating in the Shrine's charitable endeavors.

However, as the demands of life mounted – his work, family, and other commitments tugging at his time and energy – he found it increasingly challenging to maintain his active presence at the Shrine. What was initially just one missed event spiraled into two, then several more, until the Shrine seemed like a distant memory in his life.

What struck him most during his absence was the deafening silence. No phone calls, no checkins, no warm invitations to return. The bonds of brotherhood that he had come to cherish now felt superficial, leaving him with a sense of disconnection. He was left to wonder whether the unity and camaraderie he so deeply valued were simply a facade.

One evening, the absent Shriner decided to bridge the gap and took a bold step by attending a gathering at the Shrine. Sitting at the back, he felt like a stranger in a familiar place, wondering if anyone would recognize or remember him. It was then that the Potentate, the Shrine's leader, noticed his presence, and sensing an opportunity to impart wisdom, beckoned him forward.

In his hand, the Potentate held the distinctive red fez, a symbol that resonated deeply with every Shriner. It was not just a hat; it represented their commitment to one another and to the children they served. It was a symbol of unity. The Potentate began to address the assembly, "This fez," he said, "is not just a hat. It's a symbol of our commitment to each other and




to the children we serve. It signifies our unity."

Turning his attention to the absent Shriner, he continued, "Each time one of us is missing, especially when none reach out, it's as though this fez loses a thread. Over time, with more and more threads missing, it becomes frayed and loses its essence."

The metaphor was clear to all in the room, and it resonated profoundly with the absent Shriner. The room was filled with nods of agreement and silent understanding. That evening, the Al Malaikah Shrine was collectively reminded of the importance of their brotherhood, not only in the good works they did for the community but also in the genuine care and concern they should show for one another.

The Shrine was, and always had been, more than just a place for philanthropy. It was a sanctuary of unity, a haven for brotherhood, and a symbol of their shared commitment to making the world a better place. As the absent Shriner's experience showed, the threads of unity were a fragile but essential part of the Shriner's fez, and it was upon each Shriner to ensure they remained unbroken.

In our busy lives, it is easy to lose sight of the bonds that connect us with our fellow brothers and sisters, but it is through these connections that we find strength, meaning, and purpose. The Shriner's fez serves as a reminder to us all that unity and brotherhood are at the heart of any community, transcending time and distance.



This week I had the opportunity to meet the standard bearer representing Southern California Shriners Childrens Medical Center. Alissa, A sweet young girl who represents to me why we spend all this time and money, our time and money, to help these children. It is truly a remarkable story.

Alissa was born missing her left fibula and with her left femur short and bent, a condition called fibular hemimelia. Although the local doctors could not give her parents a direct answer as to what they should do, Alissa's parents went to the Shriners Open in Las Vegas in hopes that there would be someone there that could help them. She and her parents were invited to the old Shriners Los Angeles Hospital where doctors and prosthetists mapped out a medical plan just a few months after her birth. Together they helped Ali through her amputation surgery, and she was walking right after her 1st birthday.

As she has grown, Ali has received 20 prostheses, including specialized running legs for sports. She mentioned that as she was preparing for a recent surgery she waited in the music therapy room, which helped her immensely. A room which I should note the fund raising of First Lady Marsha Barsamian helped to fund in 2022.

Alissa, now 13 years old, paddleboards, bikes and hikes, and she plays second base and pitches for her travel softball team. She has earned gold medals in the Junior Paralympics for archery and track and field and holds eight national records for ages U11/U14, while breaking U17 records. She wants to play college softball and make Team USA for the Paralympic Games.

This year the Shriners Open is an opportunity for her to give back. She will be following one of the groups carrying the standard for one of the group of golfers. She also raised almost \$7,000 for Shriners Childrens through sponsorships for her as a standard bearer, and she speaks publicly as a representative for Shriners Childrens at meetings and events.

This is the result of the work we do, how we at Al Malaikah give back. When we donate to one Shriners Children event or another, when we represent the Hospitals at parades and at our lodges, when we put five bucks in the jar at a POV, we are helping thousands of young men and women to have a better and more fulfilling life. Thank you for all you do.
